Even though we no longer have a brick and mortar building, we still focus our fund raising efforts on raising money for scholarships.

As many of you know, our Alumni Association has joined with College Now, an organization whose mission is to increase college attainment in Greater Cleveland through advising, financial aid counseling & scholarship & retention services. College Now helps students as early as middle and high school, as well as adult learners achieve their dreams of going to and succeeding in certificate, two-year and four-year degree programs. College Now administers our scholarship program, with college counseling representatives in all the Cleveland Metropolitan Schools. As a result of our collaborative efforts with them, we have two scholarship recipients. We have awarded \$2000.00 in scholarships annually to two separate students since 2018, in addition to the student we are currently supporting with \$2000.00.
